Project: CLS Migrant Farm Worker Rights Project

Location: CLS offices located in Alamosa, La Junta or Grand Junction

Description of Fellow Project:

The CLS Migrant Farm Worker Division seeks an individual who share a passion for advocating for the rights of low-wage migrant and seasonal agricultural workers (farm workers). The Fellow will primarily focus on outreach to agricultural workers at labor camps and other farm worker housing sites but will also work with attorneys on farm worker client intakes and interviewing and in the various stages of litigation and advocacy related to working conditions, civil rights (including human trafficking), housing, and immigration. The Fellow will assist with legal research and writing related to current litigation and other projects as well. After an intensive three-day training in Denver, the fellow will travel to the designated region where they will be assigned and serve for the remainder of the program.

Applicant Qualifications:

The Fellow must have reliable transportation and will be reimbursed for any work-related mileage expenses. The Fellow must be bilingual in English and Spanish. CLS does not have housing available for interns, but has always been able to help provide leads or contacts for appropriate housing.
