Description of Fellow Project:

The Fellow will work with the Indian Child Welfare Act Parent Representation Project. The Fellow will gain experience in interviewing clients whose children have entered the State or Tribal Welfare system. The Fellow will become familiar with the Federal Indian Child Welfare Act, and will also spend time on outreach to the Tribal Child Welfare office and gathering information about the number of unrepresented parents involved in child welfare cases in their office. They will work under the supervision OILS attorneys in the Oklahoma City office and spend time with the attorneys discussing legal questions the student may have regarding Indian law issues.
