**Description of Fellow Project:**

Bet Tzedek is seeking a Student Fellow to assist in providing free legal assistance services to undocumented youth throughout Greater Los Angeles, Orange County, the Inland Empire, San Diego County, and cities throughout Northern California and the Central Coast.

The Student Fellow will assist Bet Tzedek staff attorneys who represent undocumented youth in need of assistance securing Special Immigrant Juvenile Status and adjusting to lawful permanent resident status. To assist attorneys, the student's workload will involve conducting intake interviews of undocumented children; preparing state court petitions and memoranda of points and authorities; observing Bet Tzedek attorneys in Immigration Court, USCIS, and Board of Immigration Appeals; responding to Requests for Evidence; conducting research to strengthen client petitions; and other assignments as needed.

- 80% direct legal services
- 20% research
